#### Lower Sac - Fishout Tuesday Feb. 9, 2010 - alt. Thursday 18th

Fishmaster – Craig Nielson

Meeting Time and Place: Posse Ground picnic tables just upstream from the Sundial Bridge at 8:30a.m.

Please remember to purchase your 2010 Fishing License.

Fishing Location: Lower Sacramento River, upper reaches (depending on river conditions).

**Equipment/Tackle**: Most folk's rod preference is a 6 or 7 wt. Tippet sizes from 3X to 4X. Sometimes tippet down to 5X for really low, clear water or dry flies. Many use Fluorocarbon tippet for clear water conditions. Plan on bringing your favorite indicator and 3X tapered leaders or 12lb Fluorocarbon to build a nymphing leader.

**Angling Methods**: With winter conditions and hopefully reasonably low flows, the most productive method will likely be nymph fishing under indicators.

The indicator set-up is the same as is used on the Trinity or Klamath Rivers, with about 4 to 7 feet between the indicator and split shot knot, followed by 12-14 inches of 3X tippet to the first fly, in turn followed by 12-14 inches of 4X tippet to the second fly.

Some angler's tie-in the leader to the indicator and/or use a level tippet, say 12lb Fluorocarbon tippet, down to the split shot knot. I prefer to attach the indicator to a tapered leader, so that it can easily be adjusted up or down and can be removed if I want to "high stick" nymph without an indicator, or switch quickly to dry fly fish.

**Flies**: #10-12 egg patterns (shrimp pink or orange for colored water and darker conditions to champagne for clearer water and lighter conditions), Alevin patterns #8-12, #6-8 Superfloss Rubberlegs, #12-14 copper johns (copper, chartreuse and red), and #14-18 flashback PTs, Micromays and other favorite BWO nymph patterns.

Toss in a few midges such as Zebras and Crystal midges #16-20. I always keep a few caddis patterns such as tan Fox Pupas or Birdsnests in the box for those sunny warm afternoons when they sometimes pop. For dries, bring your favorite BWO dries and emergers and keep your fingers crossed.

#### Baum Lake Fishout Report Jan 15, 2010

The fog was settled upon the lake, shrouding the treasure it held. As Linda and I pulled into the parking lot, our club's early birders, **Art Agnew**, **Doug Christian**, **Alan Jones** and **Dick Recchia** were putting their gear together to get on the lake as quickly as possible. Our president, **Bill Lenheim**, after a couple wrong turns, found his way to the parking lot and got ready for the day as the caravan from My-T-Fine Foods arrived. **Jerry Marks** leaped from his truck and with the help of **Earl Johnston** and **Bill Hale**, started to unload the tables for the customary morning coffee and donuts. It was now time for the lakeside chat. "Let's fish!" said I and we headed for our watercraft.

Art reported a very fruitful day of 15-20 to the boat, casting a WF intermediate sinking line on a 4 wt rod using Glen Pudwill's "B-Fly". Doug parked his craft in the honey hole and proceeded to catch between 12 to 15 fish though he swears it was more like work coaxing these fish to strike. Doug reports all but one were browns. The bulk of his catch was on an olive Stewie w/ a size 18 olive callibaetis. Dick reports that he hooked about a dozen fish and brought six to the net, mostly browns. Dick either has mega magnifiers or great patience, as he reports that his best catch fly was a size 28 tan nymph.

**Rich Artusy** says he only caught two browns on a UV Lady size 18, but what can be better than sitting in a pontoon boat on calm water, watching an indicator float slowly by and having lunch with friends. **Creighton Smith**, using a 3wt rod, ten foot leader and 5x tippet casting towards the risers with short strip retrieval, counted 15 hook-ups and 12 to the net. His go to flies were a size 18 BWO on top trailing a size 18 midge nymph tied sparsely in tan or med gold with clear glass bead and a few partridge hackles.

Stan Holt arrived a little late so he missed the early coffee klatch but was able to indulge in and comment that lunch was great as well as the company and fellowship. He reports a number of bumps but no hook-ups. Ron Ramsey caught 2 small browns and learned that stillwater fishing can be a humbling experience. He enjoyed floating on the lake and relaxing in the beauty. Bill fished from the fishing platform. He caught three fish and had the devil of a time figuring out how to land one without lifting it eight feet in the air. Earl reported that he was skunked as did Bill. Jerry released 5 small browns, shore fishing from the point behind the willow tree, using his new Chocolate Sundae fly.

**Linda Nelson** scored most of her eight fish to the net before lunch. Linda was using a 5 wt rod and drifting a size 16 olive Bird's Nest with a size 20 black wire midge with a gold glass bead dropper about eight feet down with a single BB split shot. I used a 4 wt rod with a peacock Bird's Nest and black wire red glass bead midge dropper. I landed eight fish, seven of them browns, using a wet fly swing or casting towards the rising fish. We caught fish on both flies though the midge was the main producer.

Earl sounded his air horn at 1 o'clock to call our anglers to lunch for hot chili and cornbread. Afterward, everyone returned to the lake for round two. As the day drew to a close everyone who came to the Fishout reported having a great time. Most caught some fish and all enjoyed the last nice day before the rains started.

Thanks to all who came out. It is your participation that makes our Fishouts memorable. Gerald Nelson - Fishmaster
