Note: STFF's President & Vice President are not eligible to be nominated for this award.

October Membership Meeting

Wednesday, October 10, 2012 -- Redding Public Library

Activities start at 6:30PM

Presentation by: Dennis Lee “Half-Pounder Steelhead”

Program: The life history and fly fishing techniques for half-pounder steelhead in Northern California and Southern Oregon (and their relationship to summer, fall, and winter steelhead). Dennis will also cover “sea run” Klamath/Trinity river brown trout.

Bio: Dennis P. Lee is a native Californian and earned an Associate of Science degree at the College of the Sequoias, Visalia, CA; and a Bachelor of Science degree in Fisheries at Humboldt State University, Arcata, CA. He began working for the California Department of Fish and Game in 1970 at the Nimbus Salmon and Steelhead Hatchery and has worked throughout Northern and Central California as a fishery biologist. He retired from the CDFG as a Supervising Biologist after 35 years helping manage California’s inland and anadromous fisheries programs.

He is retained by the DFG as a retired annuitant working on the preparation of a Hatchery and Genetic Management Plans for the Nimbus and Mokelumne River Fish Hatcheries; and by Cramer Fish Sciences (Gresham, Oregon and Auburn, Californian). As a consultant he is working on similar plans for the Feather River Fish Hatchery steelhead and Chinook salmon programs; and an Adaptive Management Plan for the Coleman National Fish Hatchery.

Dennis enjoys fly fishing the American River and other northern California and southern Oregon rivers for steelhead and salmon and has written a book (as yet unpublished) on the life history and fly fishing for half-pounder steelhead in Northern California and Southern Oregon. He began tying flies while attending school and continues to tie custom steelhead and salmon flies.

Procedure for Selection of Fly Fisher of the Year

- Annually, preceding the annual banquet, the president of STFF will ask the general membership and each of the previous recipients to submit nominations [based upon the criteria listed below] for the award for the current year. In addition, the president may also submit a nomination.
- All nominations must be completed using the STFF nomination form which requires a written explanation of the reason the member is being nominated. All nominations should be made in consideration of the criteria that have been established for this award.
- All members whose names are nominated will be submitted to the nomination committee for consideration. The nomination committee will be comprised of all the previous recipients of the Fly Fisher of the Year award plus the president of STFF.
- The nomination committee will submit all the members that are nominated to a vote. The member who receives a highest number of votes will be designated Fly Fisher of the Year.
- A chairperson of the nominating committee will be appointed by the President and will be responsible for obtaining all nominations and administering the voting process by the committee members. Once the voting is completed, the chairperson will report the final result to the President; otherwise the results will not be disclosed until announced at the annual banquet.

Note: In the event of a tie in the final voting, the members receiving the equal number of votes will be submitted to the Board of Directors for a vote. Each Director will have the opportunity to cast only one vote. The name receiving the highest total number of votes will be designated a Fly Fisher of the Year.

The President and Vice President cannot be nominated for this award.

Rollout of New Email System

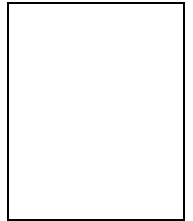
